Lakatos was not happy the township voted to spend \$2,000 and the Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation spent \$10,000 for the Greenbelt property in Northfield Township. Felt the Greenbelt should have paid for it all.

Henshaw was glad to see an active farm preserved in Northfield Township.

Zelenock was pleased for a small contribution from the Township that an active farm was preserved and the residents received a huge return on investment from the Federal Government and the Greenbelt.

Shink was pleased with the participation of the Township and the County to preserve an active farm in Northfield Township. In addition, Shink reported that Northfield Township has received \$2.4 Million from the Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation millage.
